- The abstract document should be A4 (21.0 x 29.7 cm) with top/bottom margins of 2.5 cm and left/right margins of 2.0 cm. The maximum length of the abstract is one page.
- The title should be typed in capital letters, followed by the authors' names and affiliation(s). If there are several authors on the abstract, **please underline the name who will present it.**
- **The abstract template is available on the conference website.**

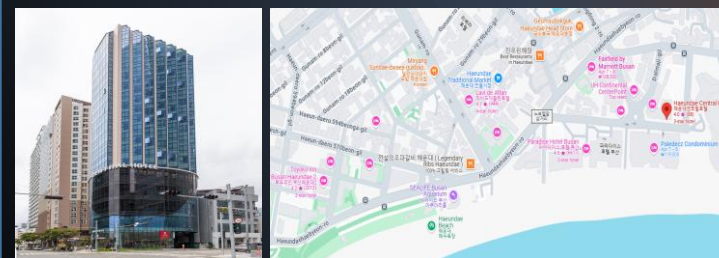
The registration fee includes a conference bag with an abstract book, tea/coffee at the venue, lunch, welcome reception, banquet, and short excursion.
